## **Need Help Paying Your Home Heating Costs?**

Fuel Assistance, also known as Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), is offered by Berkshire Community Action Council (BCAC) in partnership with the Department of Housing and Community Development. The goal of this program is to help low-income families pay their heating bills. This program runs November 1st – April 30th of each year. Once you are eligible for fuel assistance, you may also be eligible for a discount on your electric bill and you may be qualified to receive no-cost <u>weatherization</u> and <u>heating</u> <u>services</u> through BCAC.
