Old Business:

Town Beach issues were discussed. After much discussion regarding deeds and property lines of the town beach it was voted to send a letter to the selectboard requesting the town research the deeds and survey the town beach area.

Discussion regarding the pavilion for 21 Maple Street was lengthy. The goal is to have the pavilion foundation done in early spring and the wooden part of the pavilion installed by early summer. Bids will be sought for all of the work.

New Business:

Parks program for 2021 is still a question, and was tabled until more information is available.

It was voted to have the rules of the beach be handed out at the time a tax payer receives their beach permit.

It was voted that Rita Furlong would represent the Parks and Recreation Committee on the Community Preservation Committee.
