 - Issue: driveway materials not stable and washing out on to the road in front of the house
 - Motion: to approve and issue the COC subject to receiving a driveway maintenance and schedule plan to handle any future erosion by Jim, seconded by Chris, motion carried unanimously 6-0
- 2. Notice of Intent: Submitted by Alyssa Maggi for work associated with the construction of a single-family home within the buffer zone of Little Robin Lake (MassDEP #102-0465) at 0 King Richard (Map 216, Lot 285).
 - Motion: to approve a continuance to the October 25th meeting by Henry, seconded by Jim, motion carried unanimously 6-0
- 3. Request to Amend an Order of Conditions: Submitted by Daniel S. Henry Sr Living Trust for the amendment of an Order of Conditions (MassDEP #102-0447) for 168 Green Water Drive (Map 202, Lot 29). Amendment to switch proposed driveway from pervious pavers to a visible textured surface.

Motion: to approve the amendment to the Order of Conditions constructing a rain garden to the left of the driveway and place additional erosion control measures to the left side of the house by Hank, seconded by Chris, motion carried by majority 5-0-1, Henry abstained

Motion excluded in the request: the amendment to the Order of Conditions to change from permeable pavers to nonpermeable textured pavers or permeable asphalt was not included – Commissioners needed more information regarding pervious asphalt – Chair indicated he would refer this to John Verity for an opinion

Motion: to approve a continuance to the October 25th meeting regarding the use of driveway material by Hank, seconded by Chris, motion carried by majority 5-0-1, Henry abstained

4. Request for an Extension to an Order of Conditions: Submitted by Daniel S. Henry Sr Living Trust for the Extension of an Order of Conditions (MassDEP #102-0447) for 168 Green Water Drive (Map 202, Lot 29).

Motion: to approve a one-year continuance for the Order of Conditions by Hank, seconded by Chris, motion carried by majority 5-0-1, Henry abstained

5. Notice of Intent: Submitted by Jim Straub of Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation for a five-year aquatic plant management plan on Buckley Dunton Pond (MassDEP #102-0467). Plan would include the management of Eastern Purple Bladderwort and Little Floating Bladderwort from the southern cove of the Pond using mechanical removal methods.

Motion: to approve a continuance to the October 25^{th} meeting by Henry, seconded by Jim, motion carried unanimously 6-0
