## Town of Becket Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes: August 23rd, 2022

The Becket Conservation Commission (BCC) Meeting was held at the Becket Town Hall in compliance with the MA hybrid open meeting laws allowing applicants, contractors, and consultants to participate in person, virtually, or by audio.

The Chair Johnson called the August 23rd, 2022 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. having a quorum and indicated the meeting is being recorded. Chair emphasized that the meeting agenda included introduction comments that wouldn't be read and that it is the responsibility of each applicant and all others in attendance to review.

Chair opened the meeting for public comment not on the agenda. Not hearing any comments, it was closed for public comment.

## **CONTINUING BUSINESS:**

1. **Enforcement Order:** Issued to Sergey and Olga Kaletin at 0 Yokum Pond Road (Map 409, Lot 3) for violations associated with an expired Order of Conditions (MassDEP #102-0431), and unpermitted work in both wetland resource areas and associated buffer zones.

Issues: Emily Stockman presented several inconsistencies and lack of supporting documentation regarding the issuance of the "Enforcement Order" and the Notice of Intent issued in 2018. The Chair acknowledged the reason the Commission required the property owner to hire a consultant was to identify Wetland violations and provide recommendations for remediation. The Commission scheduled a site visit for August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 9:00 am. At the site visit, Emily will review the issues that are still jurisdictional to the BCC and those items that are a settled matter. She will present her recommendations to the Commission at the September 1<sup>st</sup> special meeting.

2. **Notice of Intent:** Submitted by Roy Hayes for the work associated with the development of two single family homes, the redevelopment, and restoration of Riverfront Area of the West Branch of the Westfield River and Buffer Zones on a site that had previously been a historic mill complex (MassDEP #1314467) at 1483 Bancroft Road (Map 419, Lot 6.1).
