1. The meeting called to order at 9:37 AM.

- 2. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.
- 3. Current Business Items
 - a. Aggregation vs. community solar vs. town hall rooftop --Aggregation is most expensive, but can reach the most residents
 - --Solar on the roof: 1st that must take place is roof replacement; 2nd is money being appropriated for it at town meeting
 - --RFP is hardest to do, but used when looking for an engineering firm
 - --IFB, Invitation For Bids, recommended by Ed
 - --1st: money estimated
 - --Aggregation-specific process to go through, probably not till May; every resident would get a reduction in energy costs
 - --Community Solar: waiting to hear back from school district, its participation is necessary because of its added volume; Washington has already indicated its interest in participating. A contract agreed upon for participation would have a 20-year duration, with 12% reduction for residents in energy costs
 - --Aggregation contract would have 2-5year duration, with 10-15% reduction; problem with this is not knowing where Eversource's rates will be at that point

Syncarpa seems very interested in providing community solar for our 3 entities: Becket, Washington & school district. It is looking for 250,000 kilowaat hrs. This is possible for us if the school district joins us; otherwise, it's iffy and we might have to go to aggregation.

- --Solar on roof is separate issue; it would reduce our kilowaat hours, but would make the involvement of school district critically important
- --Aggregation would take about a year to implement; community solar is faster to get, is up to Board of Selectmen
- b. If school district doesn't go in with it, we'd need to find other towns to join us
- c. Information Session is scheduled for Saturday. October 15th. Concern is losing participation of summer residents at that date. Garth will make agenda for it.
