3. Administrator's input

- a. 2020 budget is still in process
 - i. Need health insurance and CBRSD values
 - ii. New this year is \$20 k request for summer help for highway department
 - iii. Transfer station costs are up substantially due to higher recycling fees.
 - iv. It was brought up that the Wired West fee of \$1,000 is still needed. WW may ask for an increase but it will be \$1,000 at a minimum
- b. Nothing decided on capital as of yet
- c. We are in discussions with DEP on route 20 spring closure
 - i. Spring needs to be made inaccessible
 - ii. Abutter appears to have dropped any objections to us crossing his property to perform spring closure
- d. A meeting for the Johnson Road repeater tower is scheduled for February 11
- e. Still working on the Town Hall HVAC system Green Community Grant

4. Correspondence

- a. Meetings are coming up for the new Wahconah High School building project
 - i. Seven town meeting is February 21st at 7 PM at Nessacus Middle School. Tentative FY2020 Budget will also be presented.

6. Financial Reserves Policy

- a. Key change is increasing the minimum contribution the Stabilization Fund to 67% of Certified Free Cash and establishing funds to supplement Chapter 90 funds for paved road repair
