- b. Town of Washington has decided to participate in Becket Town Beach this summer (\$2500 contribution about 10% of beach operating costs plus individual vehicle beach sticker fees)
- c. Edward Pickert was accepted the position of new Highway Superintendent and will start his employment on July 20, 2020
