### 1. Meeting minutes

a. Approve minutes January 7, 2021 FC meeting

i. Motion to accept minutes with correction for header date to 2021 (shown as 2020) by MK; Seconded by DP; Approved: AS – aye, DP – aye, RD – aye; MK and CG abstained as not present

# 2. Discuss FY2022 Capital Purchase Plans/Expenses

- a. Department Heads
  - i. Highway
    - Replace Truck #5 small dump truck GMC 3500 to Ford 550 with SS body (\$132k)
      - EP recommends gas instead of diesel due to maintenance concerns
      - **b.** Marcotte Ford will take old truck in trade if we want but probably better off to auction it
    - 2. WE suggested we consider our future needs for a potential new Highway Garage; possibly on town owned Jacob's Well property
      - a. DP and WC will look at the impact of adding \$4M to the Broadband Bond to see if it looks manageable for the future

#### ii. Ambulance

- Propose we look at a Paramedic level of care versus EMT and 4 full time employees for an expected annual increase of \$25k on the operating budget
- 2. Asking to replace current Squad Vehicle it is in need of mechanical work and leaks
  - a. Feeling is current vehicle has maybe a year of use left in it
  - b. Can we look at another grant supported police cruiser and retire a cruiser for Ambulance Squad use
- 3. Department is outgrowing current garage/quarters
  - a. Possible combination with new highway garage
- iii. Parks & Rec
  - Maple Street pavilion estimated cost is \$15k
- iv. Historical Commission
  - 1. 1. Ballou Park Retaining wall \$100k
- v. Fire
  - 1. Chief was unable to attend
  - 2. Requests are: Command Vehicle (\$60k); Fire Hose (\$25k); Radios (\$15k); SCBA (\$40k)
- vi. Town Hall
  - HVAC/Reno (\$15k); TH Pavilion Expansion (\$20k); DER Culvert Grant (\$14.2k)
- vii. Operating

- 1. WC currently is working with 2% COLA
- 2. Police Salaries may be impacted by injured officer and need of Reserve Officers
- 3. County Retirement is projected up 6.2%
- 4. Transfer Station up 3.7%
- Overall the FY 2022 looks good depending on CBRSD Operating Assessment
- 3. Administrator's input
  - a. None
- 4. Annual Report
  - a. Motion to accept as written by CG; seconded by MK; approved unanimously
- 5. Broadband Update
  - a. FSA02 mostly wired, FSA01 started; lost 9 days due to weather
  - b. Sign-ups approaching 50% of households
  - c. Beta households being selected and hoping to make connections in mid-March
- 6. Other business
  - a. None

  - a. MK moved to adjourn meeting at 6:18 PM; Seconded by CG; Approved unanimously
