

Becket Center Park

Main Street, next to Town Hall

42° 16'39.07"N 73° 03'32.54"W elevation 1517 feet

Following the building of the new [Town Hall](#) in 1992, there was finally space to develop a town ballfield and play area. Funds were provided at a town meeting to level and create drainage for the park. Volunteers created a Little League regulation size field and a wooden play structure. A pavilion was built to create a Parks and Recreation storage facility and a picnic area that is used by many groups. A tether ball area and a sandlot volleyball court were then added. The paved parking lot serves as a half-court basketball court, four square game setting and provides plenty of room to jump rope. The last area to be created was a small soccer/lacrosse field. Each summer a parks program for the local children is held there.



In 2017, the wooden play structure was replaced by a colorful metal play-scape that is extremely popular with the local children as well as visiting families.



A local granite post fence was added to prevent children from running out into the highway.

In 2020, the Annual Town meeting, was held outdoor at the Becket Center Park.
