West Becket Cemetery

Jacob's Ladder Scenic Highway, Rt. 20

42° 15'49.08"N 73° 07'56.18"W elevation 1380 feet

In continuous use since 1837 this **West Becket Cemetery** is on a pleasant knoll northeast of <u>Jacob's Ladder Scenic Highway</u> and east of the intersection of Routes 20 and 8 south. Possibly the earliest grave is for Emerjane A. Sowle, who died on October 29, 1837 at age 7. Three weather-worn marble military markers are located near the front of the cemetery of the Co. B, 49th Mass. Mil. Inf. for Isaac Denslow, C. C. Hinman, and W. J. Glead. The stone wall bordering the cemetery is a memorial presented to the Town by Mr. Frank Andrews in memory of his wife, Maude. This is the smallest of the three town cemeteries.
