\* This is a request to have your name appear on the Town Caucus ballot. No signatures required. At a Town Caucus, the two persons receiving the highest number of votes cast for the nomination of candidates for an office shall be declared nominated for such office and their names will appear on the Town Election ballot. (NOTE: If a person receives less than 8% of the votes of those voting for candidates for such office at a Caucus, he shall NOT be declared nominated.)

\*\* Not less than 20 nor more than 50 signatures are required on Nomination Papers. This is to have your name appear on the Town Election ballot.
