The Town of Dalton Select Board will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, February 10, 2020 at 7:00 pm at the Dalton Senior Center, 40 Field Street Extension, Dalton, MA 01226, to seek public input on the submission of a FY20 MA DHCD Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) regional application including the towns of Dalton, Becket, Sheffield, and Stockbridge. Proposed activities include: 1) a Housing Rehabilitation Program to benefit low to moderate income homeowners and 2) a Planning Project to perform ADA Self-Evaluations and Transition Plans for the Towns of Dalton, Becket, and Stockbridge. This application will be submitted with the assistance of Berkshire Regional Planning Commission (BRPC). Residents of all four towns are invited to attend. Any person or organization wishing to be heard will be afforded the opportunity to do so; anyone not able to attend may forward their comments to Kenneth E.
