1. Call to order

BE called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. He indicated that the SB was recording the meeting.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

BE led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Broadband Update and Select Board to discuss and possibly vote on policies and decisions relating to the Broadband Project

BC read the MLP Manager's update:

- 1. Project is going well.
- 2. The section of FSA09 which was on hold will be released today except for a small area which needs additional testing. We will have a list of the premises that will be delayed in order to respond to inquiries.
- 3. FSA08 should be released the end of next week.
- 4. We reviewed the premises in FSA09 which still need underground work. Weather permitting, they will be done.
- 5. Once WCF completely stops underground MakeReady work, we will contact the premises that were not done and advise them that a temporary installation may be possible. The process will be:
 - a. Emails will go out instructing the homeowner to contact WCF Customer Service if they are interested in a temporary installation.
 - b. WCF will advise them that they need to sign a release (which we will review) so it will not be responsible if there is an accident (tripping) and that they will be responsible for the \$150 cost which is not part of the subsidy calculation.
 - c. WCF will schedule the work. If tech determines the temporary install is feasible, the work will be done the same day. If the installation is not possible, there will be no charge to the homeowner.
- 6. Starting the week of 1/3, we expect a significant increase in the number of techs available to do installs, as work in several other towns will be done.
- 7. We have reached the point where the backhaul (internet capacity) needs to be increased due to the number of subscribers and their usage. Something to be happy about.
- 8. Also, starting the week of 1/3, we should finally get the monitoring system installed in the hut.

4. Approval of the December 1, 2021 Meeting Minutes

ML moved to approve the December 1, 2021 Select Board Meeting Minutes, CS 2nd. Motion carried 3-0.

6. Jenn Beatty to discuss Becket Arts Center's upcoming application with MA Facilities Fund and future funding for the Becket Arts Center

Jenn Beatty discussed Becket Arts Center's proposal to upgrade its facility's heating and cooling systems and asked the Select Board to support town funding in the amount of \$18,500.00.

- CS will meet with Jenn next week to examine the structure in the BAC's basement.
- BC will inform the Building Inspector to expect a call from Jenn to look at the basement.
- Jenn Beatty will send BAC's proposal and Pioneer Plumbing's written estimate detailing the proposed work to BC and he will forward these to the SB and Finance Committee.
- The grant application is due on January 15, 2022. The SB will discuss this matter on January 5, 2022.

7. SB to vote on appointments:

BG received an e-mail from the Planning Board Chair specifying that Ann Krawet is serving as the Alternate Delegate to the Berkshire Regional Planning Board Commission. For this position, the SB is the official appointing authority. <u>CS moved to appoint Ann Krawet Alternate Delegate to the Berkshire Regional Planning Commission effective 7/1/2021 (backdated) through 6/30/2022, ML 2nd. Motion carried unanimously.</u>
