1. Call to order

BE called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. He indicated that the SB was recording the meeting.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

BE led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Broadband Update and Select Board to discuss and possibly vote on policies and decisions relating to the Broadband Project

MLP Manager Bob Gross provided the following update:

- There are currently slightly under 500 subscribers paying for service.
- Construction is on schedule. Service is available in Fiber Service Areas 2, 1, 5, 9 & 8. The Broadband Ad Hoc Group met with Whip City Fiber to address several premises needing connections in FSAs 1 & 5.
- FSA 4 is next in line for connection (anticipated 2/3/2022, contingent on weather). Bob advised that after Sertex reports completion of outside work to WCF, WCF has two weeks to test before installing at individual premises. FSAs 6 and 7 are anticipated after FSA 4.
- Resolution of Make Ready problems is anticipated to occur by early February (including matters related to King Richard Drive.)
- When the ground freezes, underground Make Ready will pause. Some premises with undone underground may be eligible for temporary installation. The process includes that they will need to sign a release. A technician will determine whether a temporary install is feasible. The wire, which lays on the ground, cannot cross driveways and walkways. The homeowner must pay in advance: the estimated amount over the subsidy (if applicable to the premise) and a \$150 fee (not part of the subsidy).
- Bob has been receiving words of appreciation and positive remarks about the service.

4. Approval of the January 5, 2022 Meeting Minutes

BC provided an update. Police Chief McDonough met with the Town of Otis last Thursday.

The next steps are for the Town Administrators to arrive on the salary and bring their recommendation to their respective Select Boards. The Becket SB will discuss this matter under Executive Session on February 2, 2022.

BC advised that Town Counsel agreed to eliminate the "strong police chiefs" language (3rd paragraph) in the draft agreement.

Ms. McDonough, who obtained paramedic level in November 2020, has been working per diem for the Becket Ambulance Department. She works for and has extensive experience with the Adams Ambulance Service and Southwick Fire Dept.
