  After reviewing the appointment application, CS moved to appoint Shirley Vachula to the Parks & Recreation Committee effective October 5, 2022 through June 30, 2025. ML 2nd: Motion carried unanimously.
- 8. Select Board to Vote on Town Administrator's new hire recommendation(s):
  - Thomas Dean, Highway Dept. Equipment Operator/Truck Driver effective October 11, 2022
  - Possible vote to hire Building Maintenance & Grounds Technician ML moved to accept the Town Administrator's recommendation to hire Thomas Dean, Highway Dept. Equipment Operator/Truck Driver with a start day on October 11, 2022. CS 2<sup>nd</sup>: Motion carried unanimously.

The SB agreed with CS's suggestion to pause the Building Maintenance & Grounds Technician position. CS indicated that this position was created to use Dave Shorey talents on special projects. Now that these are completed, the SB and Town Administrator will have an opportunity to review the needs of the town. In the short-term, KW has arranged for Bert Goodermote to clean Town Hall on a part-time/non benefitted basis.

## 10. Town Administrator's Report and Recruitment Update

KW provided the following update:

- Berkshire Regional Planning Commission sent an e-mail to advise that the Heavy Truck Exclusion Traffic Count study(two traffic counts) for Route 8 & 20 (East of Mass Pike), Wade Inn Road (between Route 8 and Bancroft Road0 and Wade Inn Road(between Bancroft Road and Route 20) has been completed. BRPC is paying the \$580.00 fee for the study from their annual traffic counting funds. BRPC anticipates sending the traffic counts data next week.
- Tomorrow KW and the Highway Superintendent will meet with Chris Jones/BETA to discuss Werden Road.
- Benton Hill Road KW does not believe the Hazard Mitigation grant will work out. She does not agree it would be prudent use of town resources to spend \$900,000. KW will discuss this matter with Carry Banks of the Department of Ecological Restoration.
- Based on the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission's suggestion (9/22/2022) the SB would like to revise the town's Policy on Issuing One-Day Liquor Licenses by requiring proof of liquor liability insurance for all licenses (not only for events on Town property). KW will arrange to provide a draft of the revised policy.
- The SB confirmed Trick or Treat in Becket is on Monday, Oct. 31st from 5 p.m. till 7 p.m.

### 11. Select Board's Comments and Announcements

ML asked KW to discuss speed trailers with the Highway Superintendent. ML asked KW to discuss arranging for a speed trailer to be brought for use on Route 20. CS asked KW to arrange for discuss with the Highway Superintendent placement of three or four permanent flashing speed limit signs in various town locations.

The SB agreed that it will pay \$45.00 fee for ML to attend a Mass Trails Class.

The SB discussed who will attend the Massachusetts Municipal Association Conference.
