

Greetings from the Prudential Committee, Sherwood Greens Road Improvement and Maintenance District!

We are writing to you today to update you on some of the things that we've been doing in the district and to ask for your help.

As you may know the prudential committee is responsible for allocating your road district taxes to various needs in the district. Ongoing maintenance costs such as snow plowing, ditch clearing and lake monitoring, all come from this budget. Larger expenses also are paid through these funds. In the recent past, we've replenished the sand at the beach, added substantial materials, graded, raked and rolled Long Bow Lane East and Long Bow Lane West (all of which were long overdue).

Here is where we need your help. Payment of road district taxes has been lagging this year and we really need these funds. If you've already paid up and are current, we whole heartedly thank you!

This year, timely payment is especially important as there was a mix up in tax revenue disbursements from the town. Based on deposits made in months of May, June, and July it seemed like we had sufficient funds to take on a big project, (the mailbox shed and resurfacing of Silver Leaf road). Unfortunately, we were unaware that later month funds would be reduced due to tax abatement refunds. If we were in receipt of outstanding taxes due, we would be better able to continue with maintenance and some very much needed road repairs.
