Dear Center Pond District Proprietors,

As Clerk of the Center Pond Restoration and Protection District, I would like to inform you of a Special District Meeting that will take place as required in the By-laws on Saturday, April 16, 2022 at noon. The meeting will be held at the Becket Town Hall, 557 Main Street, Becket, MA. At the meeting, we will adhere to any Covid restrictions in place at that time.

Please try to arrive promptly by 11:45 a.m. as attendees and proxies must be registered to establish a quorum before the meeting can officially start. If you have submitted a signed 2021-22 proxy, it is valid for the upcoming Special Meeting.

This April 2022 Center Pond District Special Meeting information packet consists of:

1. This letter from the District Clerk
2. Warrant for April 16, 2022 Special District Meeting (see reverse side of this letter).

Center Pond Special District Meeting Discussion and Vote:

A vote of the Proprietors is required to authorize transfer from Free Cash the amount of \$75,000. This is required to pay for services by Solitude Lake Management, LLC, related to performing an herbicide treatment to control invasive Eurasian milfoil at Center Pond. Since the funds are available in Free Cash, there is no additional cost to the Proprietors if the transfer of funds is approved.

As background, the Conservation Commission issued an Order of Conditions on December 17, 2021, permitting treatment of the lake. Treatment will take place in late spring of 2022 using the chemical ProcellaCOR, which is deemed more effective and only requires a single treatment. The approval is based on treating 90 of the 125 acres comprising Center Pond and is in accordance with the consultant's recommendations. This area is substantially larger than that treated previously.



Adjournment.


