GREETINGS:

You are hereby required to warn the proprietors of the Center Pond Restoration and Protection district in the Town of Becket, the establishment of which was provided for by the Massachusetts General Court under Chapter 243 of the Acts of 2010, to meet at **Becket Town Hall, 557 Main Street, in said Town on Sunday, June 12, 2022 at 10:00 AM;** then and there to act upon the following articles:

- Article 1:** Proprietors will vote by ballot to elect a district moderator to hold office for a term of one year and shall have similar powers to those of the moderator of a town meeting.
District Moderator – Drew Bitterman Majority Vote Required
- Article 2:** Proprietors will vote to approve the 2021 Center Pond District Annual Meeting Minutes.
- Article 3:** Proprietors will vote to approve the April 2022 Special Center Pond District Meeting Minutes.
- Article 4:** Proprietors will vote by ballot to elect a district treasurer who must be a proprietor to hold office for a term of one year.
District Treasurer for one year: John Spatcher Majority Vote Required
- Article 5:** Proprietors will vote by ballot to elect a district clerk who must be a proprietor to hold office for a term of one year, replacing retiring District Clerk David Friar.
District Clerk for one year: Fiona Friar Majority Vote Required
- Article 6:** Proprietors will vote by ballot to elect one member of the Prudential Committee to hold office for three years, replacing retiring member Anthony Limina.
Prudential Committee: one member for three years: David Friar Majority Vote Required
- Article 7:** Proprietors will vote by ballot to elect one member of the Prudential Committee to hold office for two years, to complete the term started by retiring James Laramy.
Prudential Committee: one member for two years: Elton Ogden Majority Vote Required

Article 8: Proprietors will vote to adopt the budget for the fiscal year **July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023** and the appropriation of monies to be raised by assessment upon the real property within the district held by proprietors. **Majority Vote Required**

Article 9: Prudential Committee reports: Treasurer's Report
Weed and Water Management

Article 10: Proprietors to consider such other business as shall be consistent with the power and authority conferred by Chapter 243 of the Acts of 2010 upon the district.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof in one or more public place within the Town of Becket fourteen days at least before the time of meeting, as aforesaid, and you are further directed to send a copy of this warrant by first class mail, postage prepaid, to each proprietor of record of the District at least fourteen days prior to the time of the meeting, as aforesaid, and make due return of this warrant with your doing thereon to ourselves at or before the time of said meeting, as aforesaid.


