

The Town of Becket's **ANNUAL TOWN CAUCUS** will be held at Becket Town Hall on **Saturday, April 6th, 2019, from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.** to cast ballots for the nomination of candidates for the following offices to be filled at the Annual Town Election on May 18, 2019:

- Member, Board of Selectmen (3-year term)
- Member, Board of Health (3-year term)
- Cemetery Commissioner (3-year term)
- Two (2) Members, Finance Committee (3-year terms)
- Member, Planning Board (5-year term)

Any candidate requesting that his/her name appear on the ballot for the Annual Town Caucus must file a Caucus Nomination Paper with the Town Clerk by 5 p.m. on March 15, 2019. No signatures are required and the two persons receiving the highest number of votes cast at the Caucus shall be declared nominated for such office and their names will appear on the Annual Town Election ballot. Please note that if a person receives less than 8% of the votes of those voting for candidates for such office at a Caucus, he shall NOT be declared nominated.

If you plan to run for office in 2019 but choose to forego the Caucus, you must obtain Nomination Papers from the Town Clerk's office by 5 p.m. on March 27, 2019. At least 20 signatures of registered voters in the Town of Becket are required and the last day and hour to submit Nomination Papers to the Registrars of Voters for certification is 5 p.m. on March 29, 2019, in order for your name to appear on the ballot for the Annual Town Election.

All candidates must be registered voters in the Town of Becket.

There will also be a SPECIAL ELECTION on the Wahconah Regional H.S. funding ballot question held concurrently with the Caucus at the same time and location.
