

Special Town Election Minutes 6/28/03

Pursuant to the foregoing warrant, a Special Town Election was held in the Becket Town Hall, 557 Main Street, on June 28, 2003.

The polling hours were 12:00 noon to 7:00 p.m. There were 10 absentee ballots. A total of 133 voters participated and cast ballots. The results of the election are as follows:
